

JR. RODEO RULES

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2008

The Scottsdale Saddle Club Code of Conduct will be enforced at all times

The USTRC rules will apply and be enforced at all Scottsdale Saddle Club Junior Rodeo Series events. Please see [The United States Team Roping Rules](#)

The USTRC dress code will not be enforced.

The age of the rider as of January 1st will determine the age group the rider will compete in for the year.

At the judge's discretion, a rider may be disqualified for horse abuse, unsportsmanlike conduct, lack of control or unsafe situations.

Time will not be given for major tack changes, please be prepared.

All riders must wear boots with a heel of ½" or greater, long pants and use a western type saddle.

NO FATBABY BOOTS ARE ALLOWED.

Rodeo chairperson/committee member, judge or designated person's decision is final.

No refunds once entries are paid. Refunds will not be given due to poor weather, dropped events, DQ's or lameness.

No racing horses in the warm up arena or parking lot.

Riders must walk their horses at all times when outside the arenas.

No horses allowed in the bleacher area or around the announcer's stand.

The use of profanity or abusive language by any contestant will result in disqualification from that event and could result in disqualification from the entire rodeo series.

Any act of discourtesy or disobedience toward any Rodeo Official/Board or Committee Member, in and out of the arena, will result in disqualification for the duration of the rodeo. It could also result in removal from all SSC events and activities for the remainder of the year.

Any grievance must be submitted in writing before the end of the rodeo and may not be discussed at the announcers stand.

All Horse Lovers Park rules must be followed.
